Australian 10,000m Walk Championships Canberra, Sunday, January 14th

The Athletics Australia open 10,000 metres track championships are being conducted in Canberra this Sunday morning. There has been some controversy since the race walks were brought forward to January 14th instead of being part of AA Open Track Championships on the Gold Coast in mid-February. Last year there was a single combined race. This year given the number of entrants there are separate men and women's races.

Queensland will be represented by defending champion Katie Hayward and Jessica Pickles in the women's 10,000 metres. Luke McCutcheon is our sole representative in a huge field of 36 entrants in the men's race. The races include a large contingent of overseas athletes who are currently in Canberra as part of an AIS Nutritional Study camp . We wish the walkers all the very best this Sunday.
