Queensland Track Classic Scorching Times & a World Record

Katie Hayward demolished her own State U20 3,000 metre record and smashed Jane Saville's Australian U20 record (12:27.74) at the Queensland Track Classis at QSAC on Saturday night with a time of 12:10.17. It has now been noted that this is a **World U20 best ever time** for the distance. Congratulations on a huge performance. Katie even had time to have a good look at her watch turning into the home straight.

The race was won outright by Dane Bird-Smith with a scintillation time of 11:01.32. The performance highlighted what a fantastic Dane's Australian record of 10:54 really is. Nelson McCutcheon was next in, just missing breaking 13 minutes (13:00.30) and a great return to form by Clara Smith with 13:03.64. So many other walkers smashed Pb's in a night of action.

The record breaking form of Katie Hayward continued in the 3000m walk. Clocking 12:10.17 in the 3000m walk, to break Jane Saville's mark of 12:27.74. The time was also a World U20 best ever time.
