

Tropical Cyclone Alfred headed for Queensland and New South Wales coast

Tropical Cyclone Alfred is looking more likely to make landfall in Brisbane's northern suburbs, with the worst impacts to be felt to the south of the system, according to the Bureau of Meteorology.

It was upgraded to a category 2 overnight and is likely to maintain that intensity as it approaches the coast.



Be Aware & be Prepared Stay Calm and be Kind

Have you prepared an emergency kit?

Cyclone Alfred may cause your home to lose power, water and gas. You may also not be able to reach supermarkets or a pharmacy.

Consider ensuring that you have:

Non-perishable food to last 3-4 days

Water for drinking and cleaning (3L per person per day)

Toilet paper

Medication (if needed)

First aid kit

Batteries

Torches

Valuable documents such as passports, ID, birth certificates, in a safe place Portable chargers for phones

Radio to stay up to date with local alerts

Plan a safe place to shelter

Plan for either a safe room or two in your house, or a shelter building elsewhere. A safe room could be a hallway, a bathroom, or a big walk-in wardrobe. It needs to be away from windows, in case they are broken by flying debris.

Cyclone Alfred is expected to make landfall as a category two cyclone on Thursday night or Friday morning.

What does that mean?

Liz Ritchie is a professor of atmospheric sciences from Monash University and an expert in tropical cyclones and extreme weather events.

She says a category two system is moderately intense, but still very impactful, and could see:

- Sustained surface winds between 90 and 110kph.
- Swells of up to 10 metres in height while it's over the ocean.
- Heavy rain on the south side of the cyclone.

Dr Ritchie warned of high tides, heavy rain, and flooding as the cyclone moves closer to the coast.

And there could be additional flooding depending on when the cyclone makes landfall.

"If it comes in when you're on a low tide, then it's not so impactful, but if it comes in on your high tide, then it can be quite impactful,"

Brisbane City Council is warning 20,000 homes could be impacted by TC Alfred.

Lord Mayor Adrian Schrinner says "residents at risk from significant storm surge and flooding are urged to consider relocating".

According to new council modelling areas <u>most at risk include Nudgee Beach</u>, Brighton, Windsor, Ashgrove, Morningside and Rocklea.

"Properties could experience anything from mild inundation in their yards to significant flooding in their homes," Mr Schrinner says.

The storm surge is expected to peak from Thursday.

Call **Urban Utilities** on **13 23 64** for leaking water pipes, sewerage and wastewater, drinking water supply issues.

Call **Energex** on **136 262** for fallen power lines and power outages, for status of creek and river alerts, road closures, power outages, evacuation centres and warnings.

What else can you do?

Clean your outdoors from anything that could be picked up by wind All of your gardening tools, bikes, and plants need to come inside. Loose branches need to be trimmed, and sent to a green waste tip ASAP. Anything else loose needs to be tied down, stored, or removed. You don't want your old shovel flying into your neighbour's window.

Stay safe, look out for your families, your friends, your neighbours, the elderly and don't forget to take care of your pets.
