

Caleb Maybir 70 today

Caleb was born and educated in Fiji and came to Australia for life saving medical treatment after a car accident. He settled in Sydney becoming a taxi driver and started race walking. He represented NSW before moving to Queensland. Caleb was a regular competitor in State 20,30& 50km championships for many years and was a regular QRWC representative in the 20 miles at the LBG Carnival in Canberra. He represented Fiji at the Lugano Cup (now known as the World Athletics Race Walking Team Championships) and won a gold medal for Fiji in the 20km at the Oceania Games.

Calebs biggest achievement in race walking was becoming a Centurion (walking 100 miles in under 24 hours. His favourite number is 28th. He was born on November 28th 1954 and began his Centurion race on the 28th (September 1996) at QSAC. He became Australian Centurion number 28 in doing so. The QRWC planned and put on the event which was a fund-raiser for the Queensland Epilepsy Foundation. The 24 hour event was supported by a 100km race and a 24 hour race walk relay event. As was his tendency, Caleb started fast, passing 50 km in 6:13:06 and his 50 mile mark of 10:25:43. He looked well on track but then the early pace caught up with him and he faltered. He suffered badly in the second half of the race and it was only with the grim determination to get his Centurion badge and the urging of his crew and club members that he was able to hold his form and finish in 23 hours 34 minutes 20 seconds.

Who this Policy Applies To

This policy applies to the following, whether they are in a paid or unpaid/voluntary capacity:

- Parents, guardians, spectators and sponsors to the full extent that is possible.
- Individuals appointed or elected to boards, commissions, committees and sub-committees;
- Employees and volunteers; Support personnel (e.g. managers, physiotherapists, psychologists, masseurs, sport trainers, etc);
- Coaches and assistant coaches (whether or not they are accredited)
- Athletes, coaches, officials and any other personnel participating in any teams, events and activities, including camps and training sessions, conducted or sanctioned by Queensland Athletics Referees, judges and other officials.
- Members, including life members.
- Member associations and each of its members, including life members.
- Affiliated clubs and associated bodies of Queensland Athletics;
- Peak associations and other State bodies engaged in any form of athletics.
- Any other person or body that is a member of or affiliated to Queensland Athletics.
