Queensland Athletics Registration 2018/19

Registrations with Queensland Athletics for the 2018/19 season become due on October 1st. The portal is now live and will accept membership applications. Click on the QRWC as your club. To avoid the problems some members have previously experienced the options on the portal are for QA registration only. No QRWC club fee as it is recognized that <u>our members are already financial with the club up until April 1st 2019</u>. If you are not

a current financial member of QRWC please contact the club at qrwcregistrar@outlook.com

Base members may only compete in a maximum of 3 track and field competitions during the summer season, including QA Shield Meets, other QA Track & Fields Meets and QLD Track & Field Championships. Base members are not eligible to compete at the 2019 Australian Athletics Championships (U14-Open).

Minimum Ages: <u>Track & Field</u>: 12 years as at 31 December 2019 (born 2007). Younger athletes may join as a Base Member for club training and for access to cross country and walks competitions. <u>Cross Country / Road Walking</u>: 6 years as at 31 December 2019 (born 2013).
