All competitors please take note

A timely reminder from the judges to all race walk competitors that TR 54.4.1 will be in force at these championships .This rule states in part: "the Chief Judge has the power to disqualify an athlete in the last 100m, when their mode of progression obviously fails to comply with Rule 54.2 of the Technical Rules *regardless of the number of previous Red Cards the Chief Judge has received on that athlete.*"

Please ensure everyone complies with the two rules of race walking in their entirety to avoid this issue.

Another very important consideration is for athlete to ensure that they correctly walk across the finish line, don't pull up before the finish. Try to finish at least 2-3 metres past the finish line otherwise you could attract a red card which might be the difference between getting through or not.
